Updating Data in Gold Rush

Asking for yearly updates

Original Data extracted Summer 2019 Registration anomalies? Inventories? Mold?

Will send request for data in August, with instructions. Exports can be from ILS or a Collection Query in OCLC.

Special Collections Working Group

- Special Collections Working Group started meeting in May to investigate expanding the scope of the EAST collection to include print monographs and journals held in special collections locations
- Split into two subgroups:
 - **Collection Analysis**, pilot project using Gold Rush to compare 6 libraries' collections
 - Policies and procedures, draft policy on resource sharing & more detailed procedures/workflows



New Working Groups

Based on result of 2020 EAST Program Assessment forming two new working groups:

- Access WG, operational issues associated with maximizing access to the EAST collective collection.
- **Collection Analysis WG,** developing recommendations for what the future approach to collection analysis for EAST should be.

JOURNAL RETENTION AND NEEDS LISTING (JRNL)

- 21 EAST members have agreed to use the JRNL Gap Filling Tool to work with fellow Rosemont libraries on filling holding gaps in retained journal holdings

- Working on setting up member accounts & appointing library reps on JRNL Oversight Committee
