EAST Disclosure Policy

The EAST Disclosure Policy states that "EAST Retention Partners will <u>record EAST</u> <u>retention commitments in their local catalogs</u> to prevent withdrawal of these volumes. Retention Partners will also disclose EAST retention commitments in regional and national/international systems (e.g., OCLC WorldCat) in ways that are consistent with emerging national or international standards."



The 583 "Action Note"

Shared print programs have been encouraged to use the marc <u>583 "action note"</u> to record retention commitments. You may read more about this recommendation in the OCLC Detailed Metadata Guidelines: https://goo.gl/P1Tc7Y

Subfield z: public note	Optional public note field. May display in the OPAC in some systems.
Subfield 3: materials specified	Optional (though recommended) field for use with multipart monographs that describes the extent of the holdings being committed.



If your library has multiple items associated with an allocated bib record, ALL of those items have been flagged in GreenGlass to be retained.

A note about multi volume sets

Multi Volume sets may have been assigned if a library is either the only holder of that oclc number, OR if SCS could determine that the library holds a superset of all volumes held by the partner libraries.

Libraries may be assigned incomplete sets, e.g. v.1, v.2, v.4

OpenRefine Recipe for Multipart Monographs

Starting with xlsx downloaded from greenglass, save it as a .csv file Import into OpenRefine

- On WorldCat OCLC column choose Edit column / Move column to beginning
- On WorldCat OCLC choose Sort
- On WorldCat OCLC choose Edit cells / Blank down (make sure you are on ROWS view)
- On Enumeration choose Edit cells / Join multi-valued cells (default is comma separated, which is fine)

Again MAKING SURE YOU ARE ON THE 'ROWS' (not records) VIEW:

- On Worldcat OCLC choose Facet / Customized facets / Facet by blank
- On All choose Edit rows / Remove all matching rows
- Remove the facet on blanks.
- On Enumeration choose Edit Cells, Transform: value.replace("*", "") removes all those asterisks



Adding 583s to LHRs in WorldCat

The OCLC Shared Print Registration service is currently in beta testing.

It batch creates LHRs with 583s and sets a new Shared Print flag on the records.

It does not handle multipart monographs at this time

EAST members will be advised when this service is available, and training will be provided.

- Download your final retention list from GreenGlass
- Review instructions for adding 583s to your ILS. Decide how to handle multipart monographs
- Record retentions in your ILS by June 4, 2018 and let EAST know that this work has been completed
