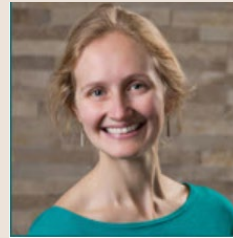

Q10: What is the importance of the following WEST objectives to your institution? (n=71)

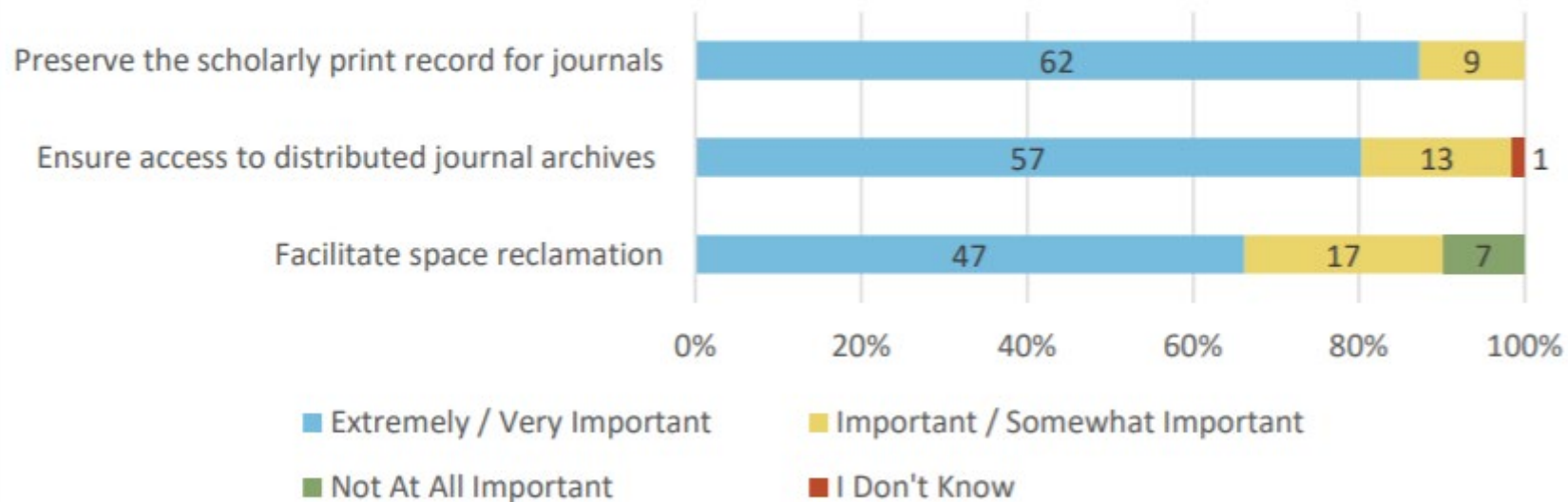


Figure 3. Respondents were asked to rank the importance of each of the three WEST program objectives.

Q8: Why does your institution participate in WEST? (n=71)

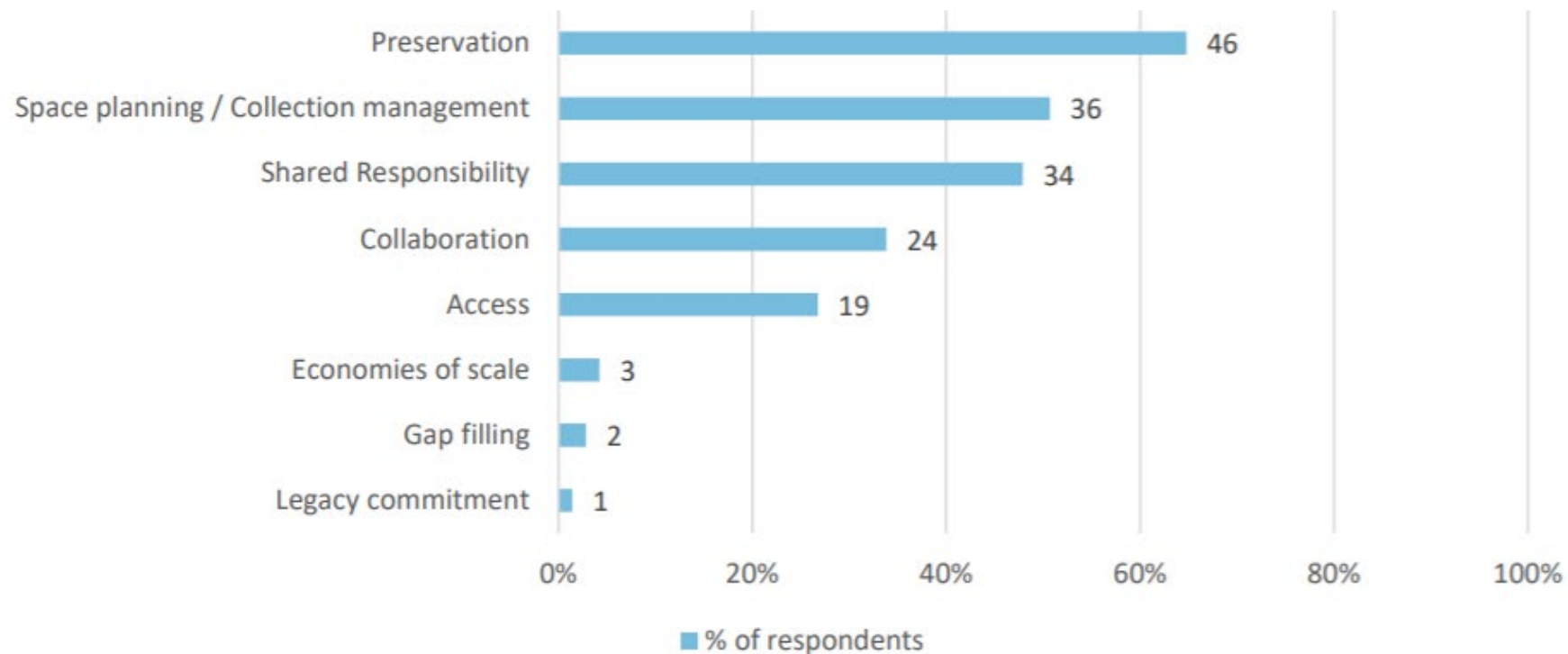


Figure 4. Members were asked to share their reasons for participating in WEST (Q8). Responses may be coded into more than one category.

Our Library's membership in WEST will ensure that our weeding project will not endanger our access to (or preservation of) our legacy print collections. In addition, we recognize that the academic library community is a "commons" with shared interests and responsibilities. Q28: Local challenges to participating in WEST (n=46)

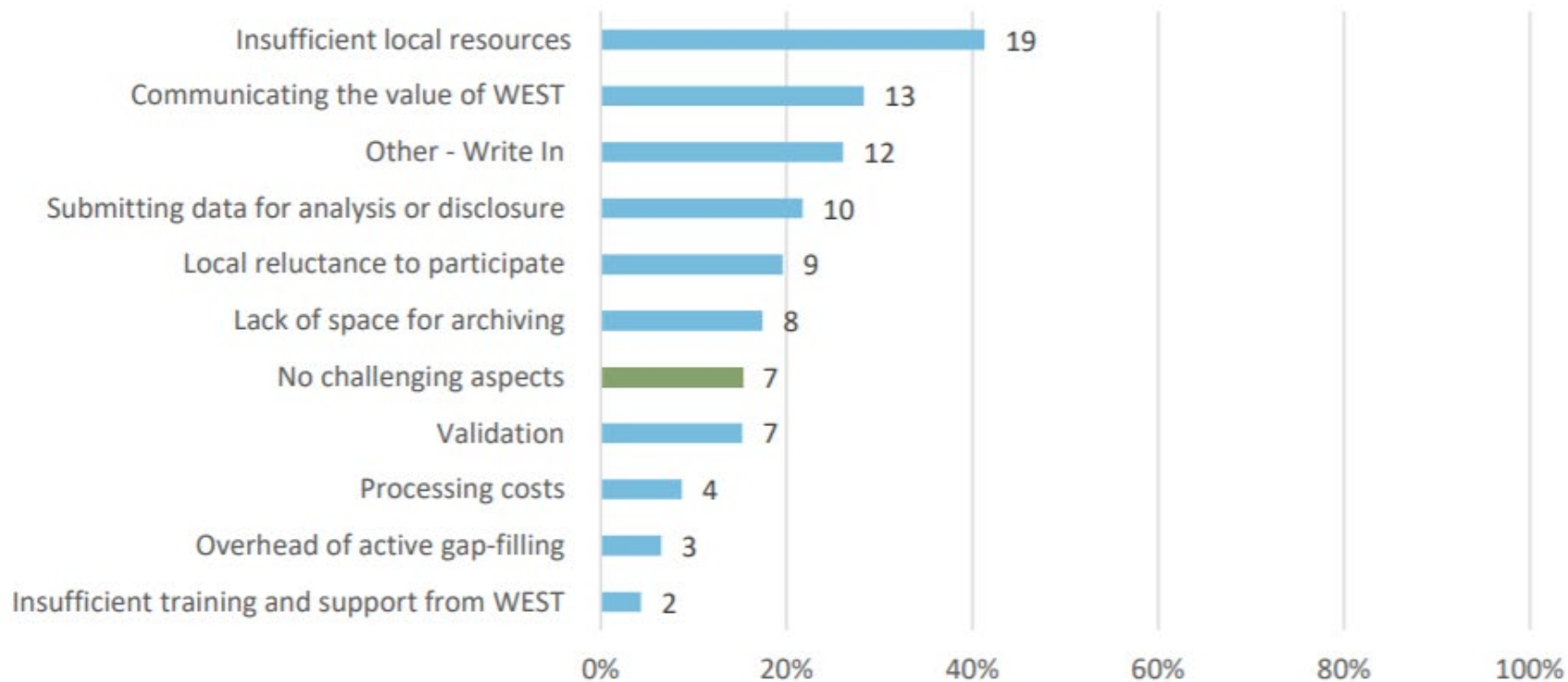
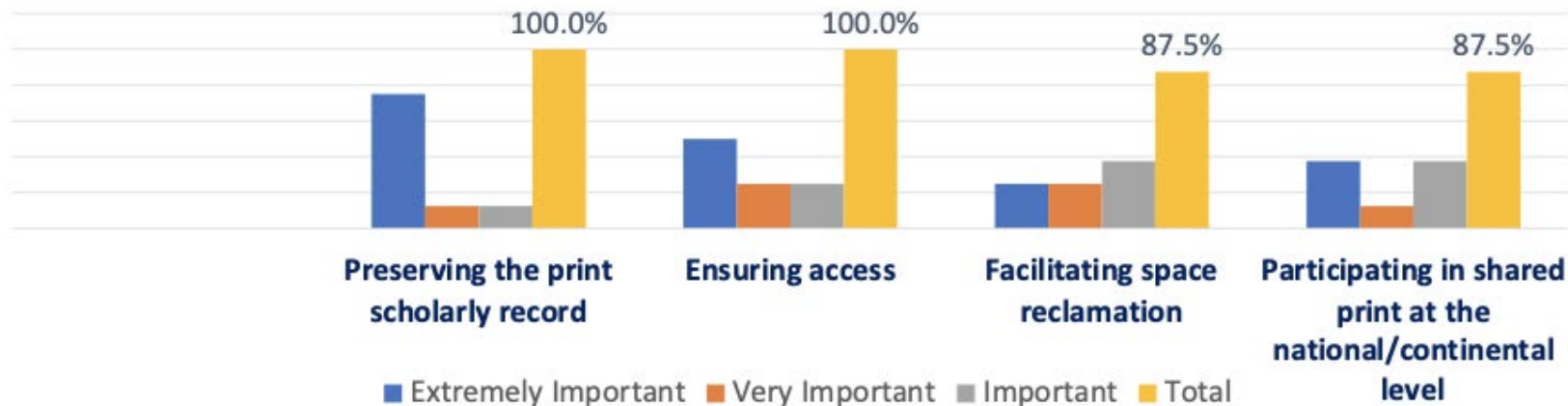


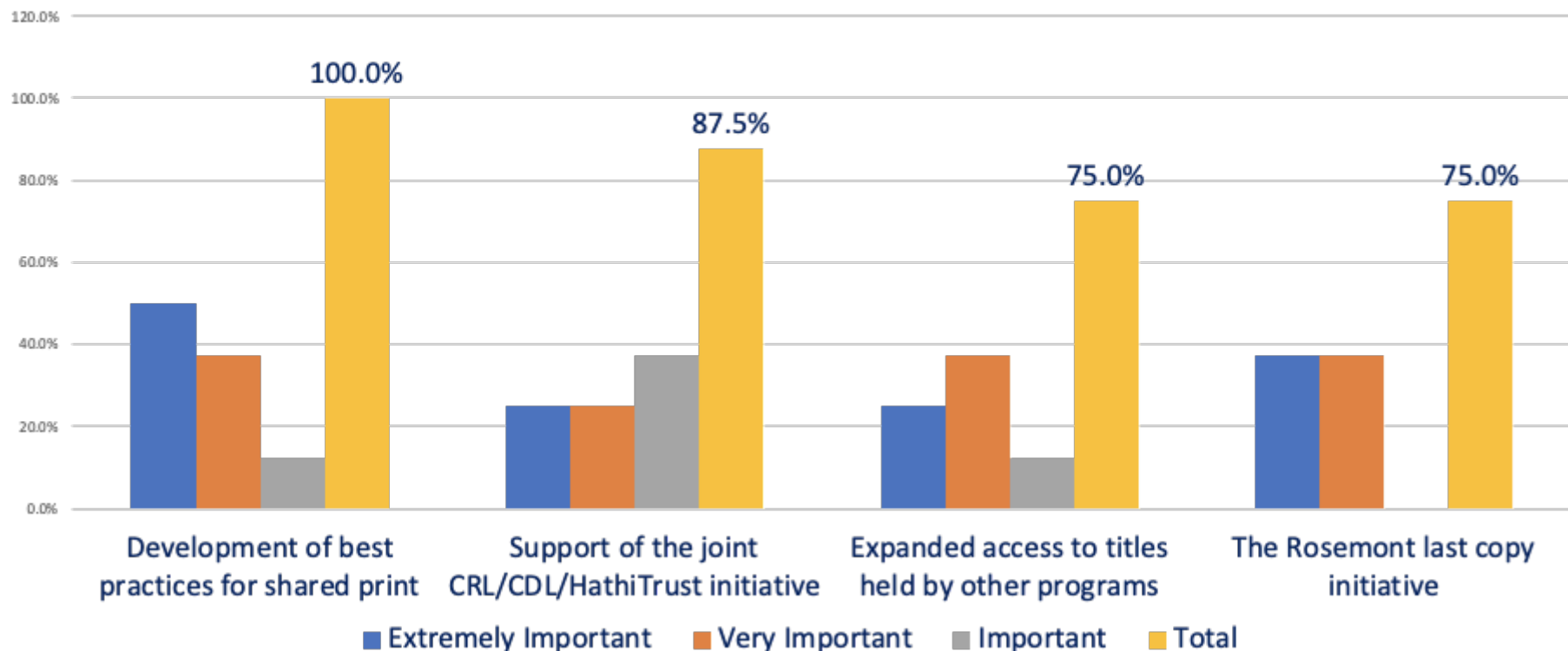
Figure 6. 'Insufficient local resources' is the most commonly cited challenge to participating in WEST, though several did note that they do not face local challenges. Respondents could make more than one selection. (Q28)

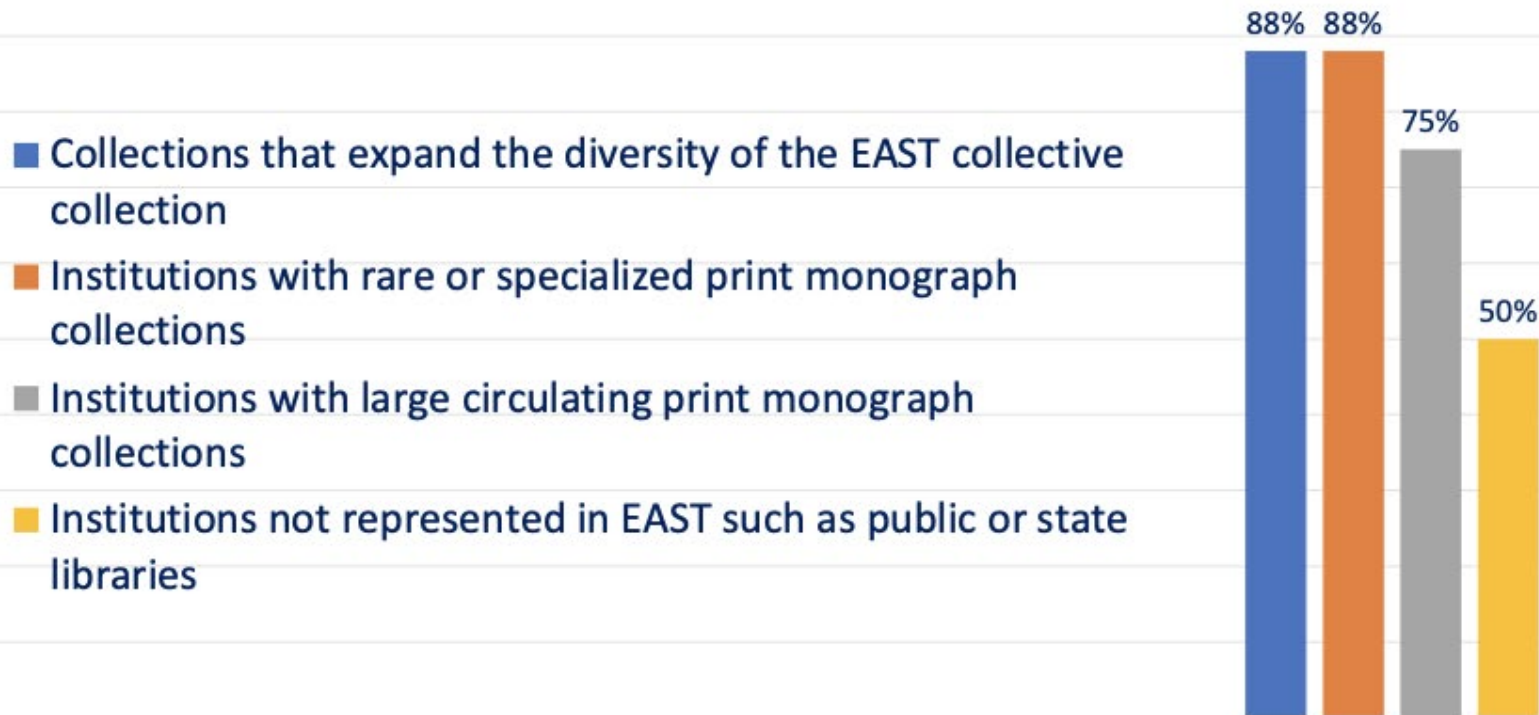
As you think about the EAST mission, what is the importance of each of the following to your institution?



Initiatives that are most important as part of EAST's collaboration with the larger shared print community



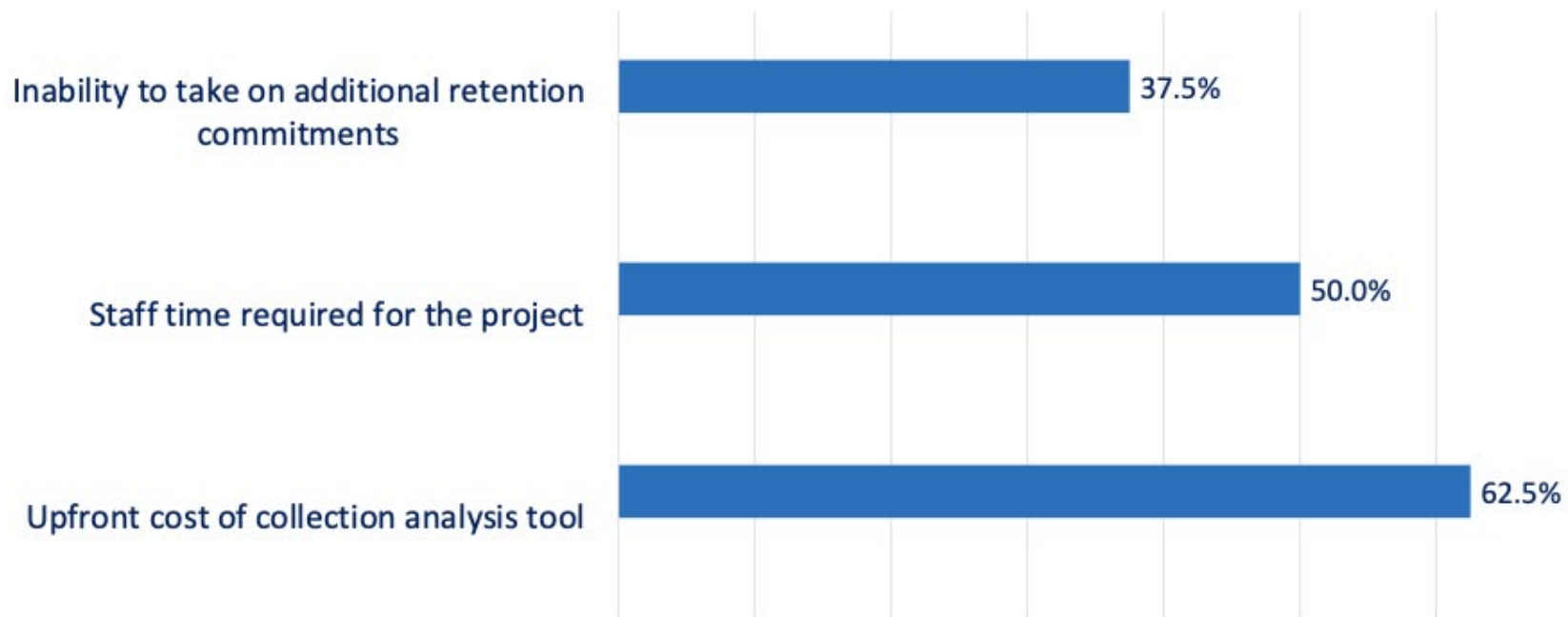
As EAST grows its membership, what types of institutions should be prioritized for outreach?



Strategies that are important to the future mission of EAST – Focus on **Access**

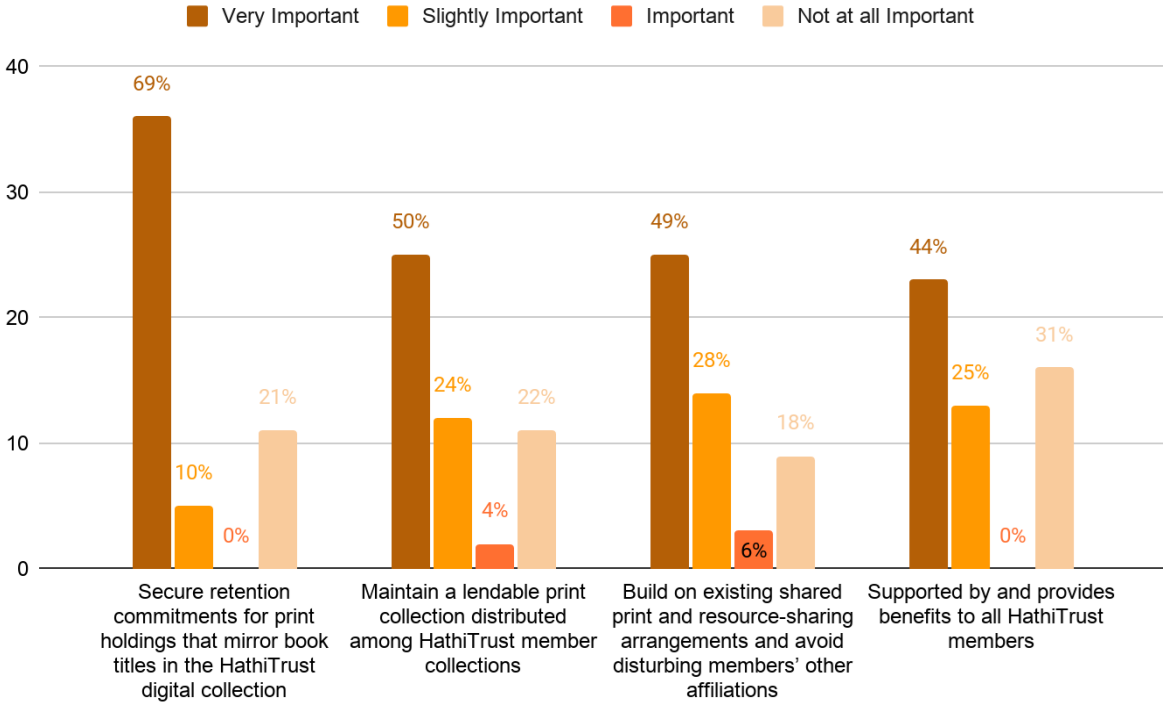
- 100% believe it is important for EAST to facilitate digitization of EAST retained titles in support of expanded access

Factors that would prevent participation in future collection analyses/making additional retention commitments

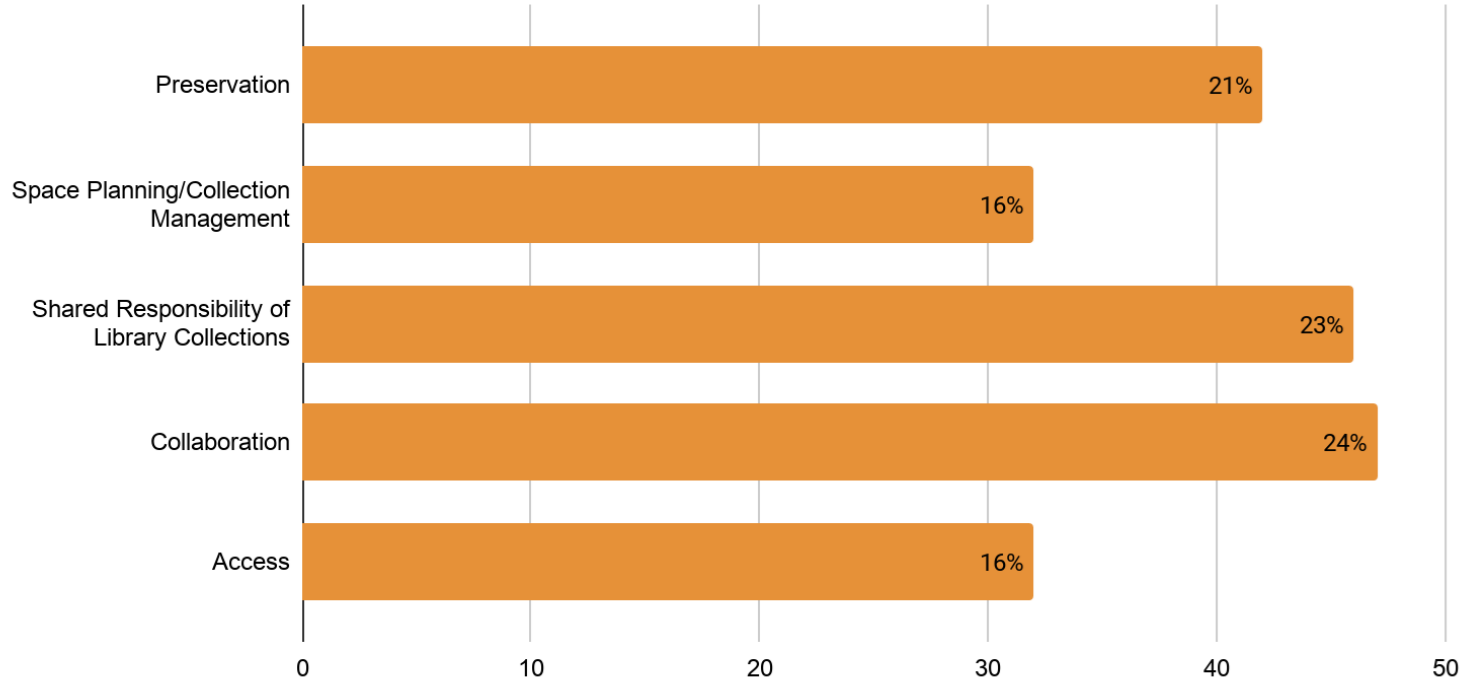
