
- Validate, normalize, and compare holdings across libraries







Recording retentions for serials is very similar to recording retentions for monographs.

The 583 is used with an additional normalized holdings statement in a subfield '3'. For EAST these will always be closed holdings, as libraries will be committing only to what they currently own. These holdings ranges may be extended at any time if the library so desires. A breakdown of the marc 583 for EAST serials/journals is below. A single "committed to retain" 583 is required.



If a library is also doing validation of serials holdings, two additional 583s\*\* may be used to record this information. These have the subfield 'a' of 'condition reviewed' or 'completeness reviewed'. While validation is not required, most EAST Serials and Journals Partners have expressed a desire to do volume level validation of holdings before assigning retention commitments. This can be recorded in the subfield 'i' using either 'volume-level', issue-level' or 'page-level' depending on the level of validation conducted. Subfield 'i', status, may also be used to note problems, e.g. gaps. See the preferred print archiving terms in the Preservation & Digitization Actions: Terminology for MARC 21 Field 583 (PDA), and note this terminology is used by including a subfield '2' of pda. Use the ‡z Public Note to specify the physical units for which condition or completeness problems have been identified.

## Recording Commitments in OCLC WorldCat

- Current not available, but OCLC-CRL collaboration to support improvements in the WorldCat infrastructure for managing shared print collections. Including both the registration, discovery and access to large scale data.





## EAST @ the Bleeding Edge

- Most serials/journals projects have focused on specific publishers or subjects where detailed collection analysis & allocation is not required
- Serials collection analysis is HARD
- Still new for CRL so setting expectations and ongoing communication have been critical
- Dirty data lessons
- More selective retention than with monographs



## Policy on Replacing Serial & Journal Titles

For serial and journal titles, EAST members are encouraged to donate their copies to Retention Partners to help fill gaps, but replacement is not required for these material types.



## Gap Filling Procedure

EAST libraries planning on withdrawing serial and journal titles are encouraged to first check the EAST Retention Database to identify whether the titles have existing EAST commitments and if there are gaps in the holdings of the retained titles which they could fill.

If your library's holdings could fill gaps contact the holding EAST Retention Partner library with the Title, OCLC number, and your holdings range.

If the EAST retaining library is willing to accept a physical transfer of issues to fill gaps they should follow EAST procedures for updating retention commitment statements in catalogs.

Shipping costs will be negotiated between the libraries and at their own expense.


