



- Leader in shared print nationally








Number of Copies Retained




Visualizing the EAST Serials & Journals Collective Collection - Scarcely Held

Overview (29,525 Titles, 32,591 Holdings)


LC Holdings Count




Pub Start Year




- Complete serials and journals work
