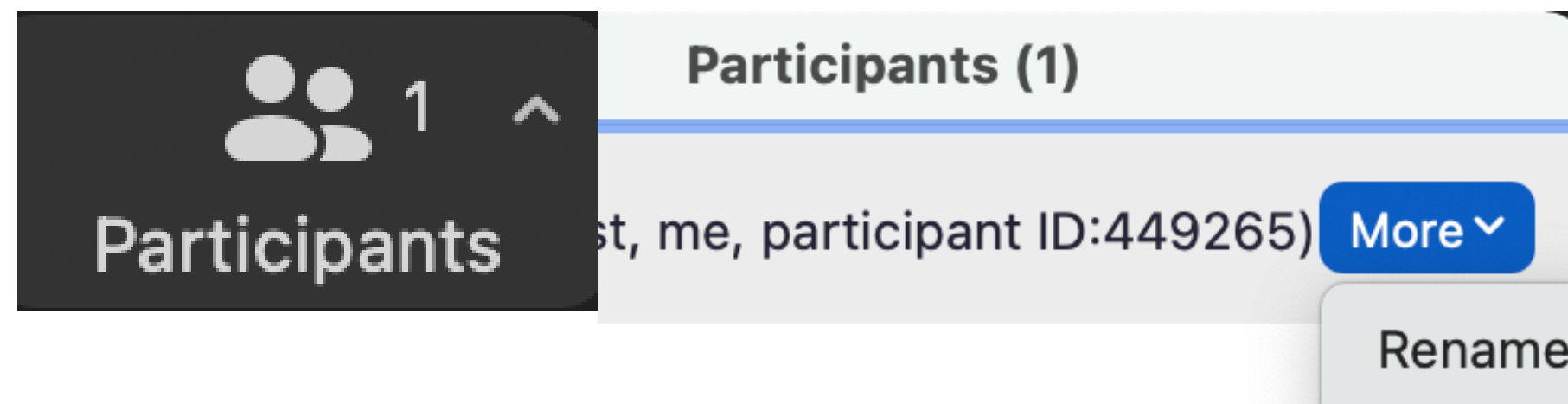

 - Executive Committee Member for Partnership for Shared Book Collections (2020-22)



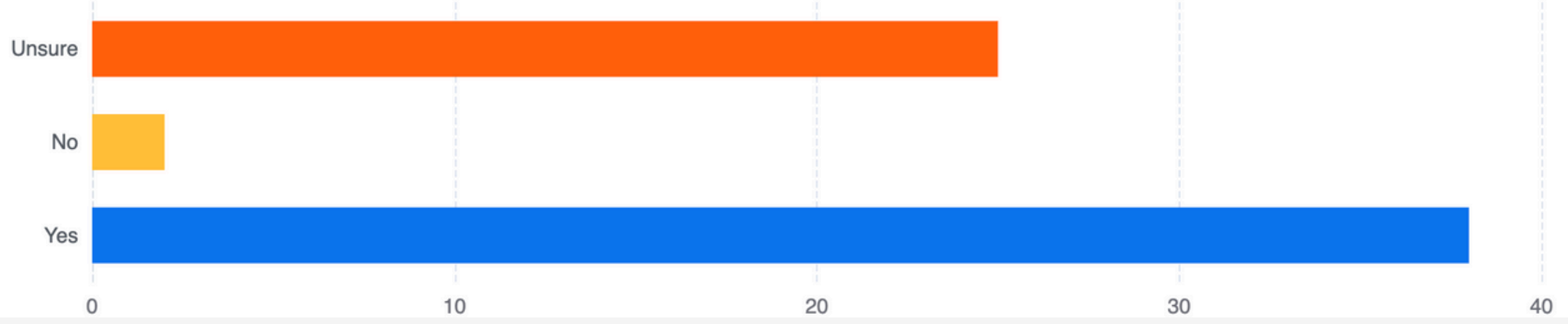

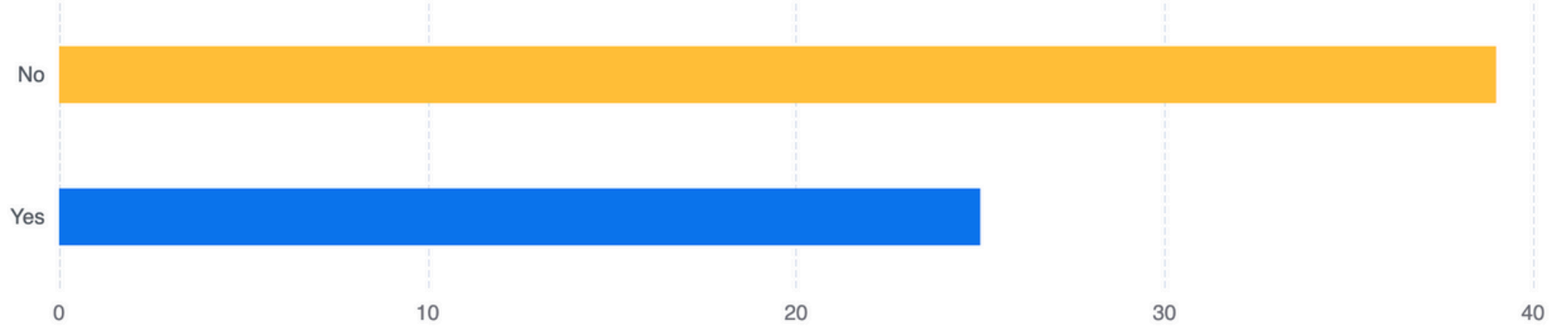

- 67 Libraries participated in the 2011-2021 analysis
- Over 7 million records submitted, 2+ million allocated
- Allocation based on geography and % already retained

HBCU Cohort

- Funding from IMLS as part of the *Community Strategies to Expand the Diversity and Inclusivity of the Collective Collection of Shared Print* to work with HBCU libraries
- **Virginia Union University** in Richmond, VA has joined EAST and will be reviewing potential retention commitments in August
- **Hampton University** and the **Atlanta University Center** joined them in a group collection analysis subsidized by the IMLS funding and will be discussing possible membership with EAST in the coming weeks
- SCELC, the lead on the planning grant, is completing an analysis of both HBCU and HSI collections based on FAST headings and will be reporting out to the community later this year
