



- Thank you for checking your lists
- Over 30% of requested in-scope titles were able to be reallocated
- Many other titles not reallocated due to special collections locations
- Reminder that digitized surrogates of copies of titles in special collections can fulfill the 'circulating' requirement of EAST retentions

Collection Analysis Results

- 67 Libraries participated in the 2011-2021 analysis
- 1.8 million additional commitments added
- Tested geographical distribution of retentions

Which Collection Analysis Tool Is Right for My Library?

Comparison of GreenGlass, Gold Rush, and Choreo Insights¹

| Function | GreenGlass | Gold Rush | Choreo Insights | Notes |
|--|------------|-----------|--------------------|---|
| Check quality of records input into system | X | | N/A | GreenGlass checks the accuracy of the OCLC number, and creates remediation lists for errors found. Gold Rush does not do any quality checking on records submitted. Choreo Insights relies on data already in WorldCat and the accuracy of holdings set there. OCLC does offer a free "light" reclamation before a Choreo analysis for OCLC cataloguing subscribers, so holdings data can be cleaned locally before being reloaded into OCLC. |
| Compare overlap with other libraries | x | Limited | x | All three tools allow libraries to run comparisons between their holdings and other libraries. This includes comparisons with both individual libraries and groups of libraries. |
