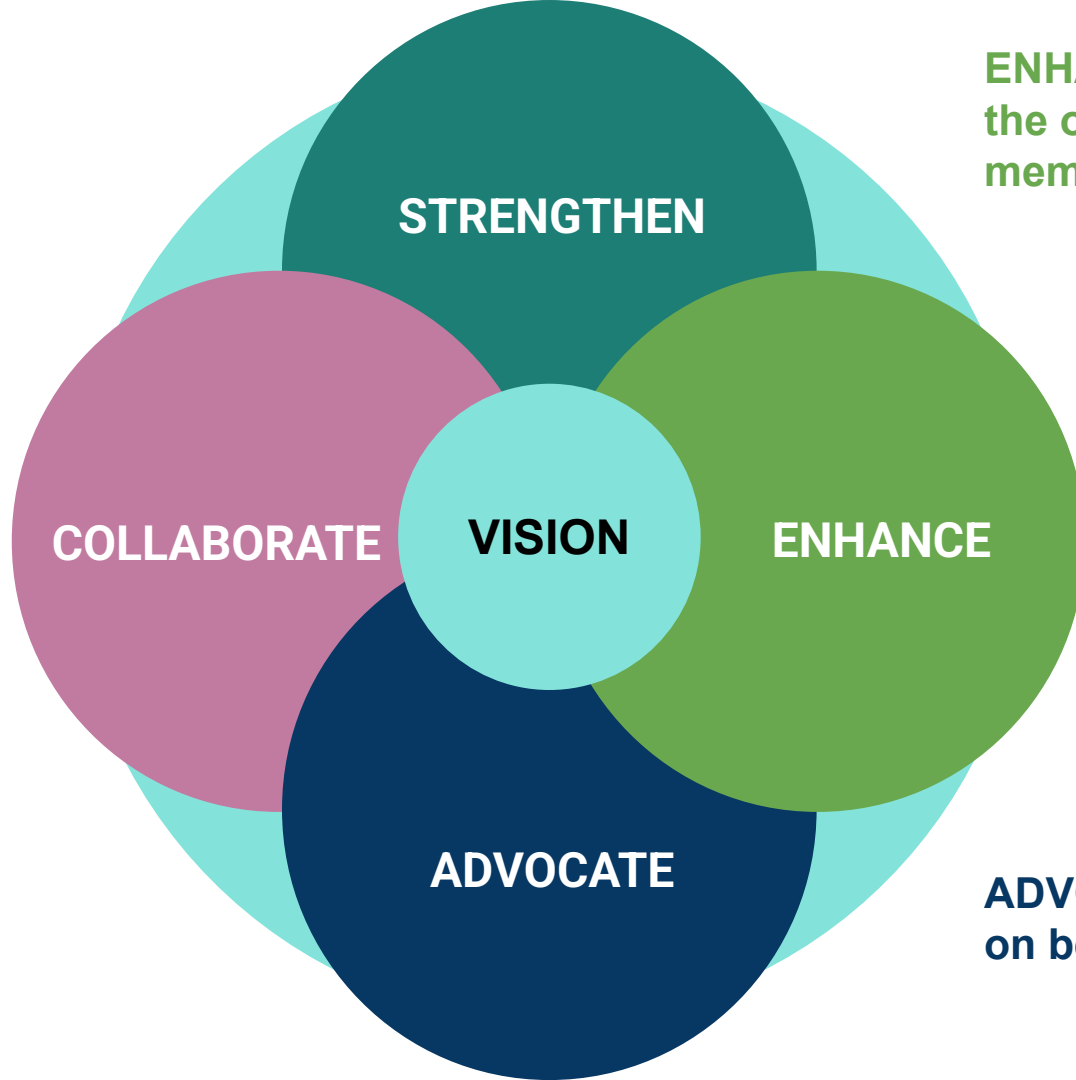

- Strengthen resource sharing among member libraries
- Diversify the EAST collective collection
- Improve documentation (e.g., policies and practices)
- Greater emphasis on sustainability and long-term preservation of content
- Guidance for libraries in danger of institutional closures
- Simplify and streamline to make participation as easy as possible
- Grow membership in EAST

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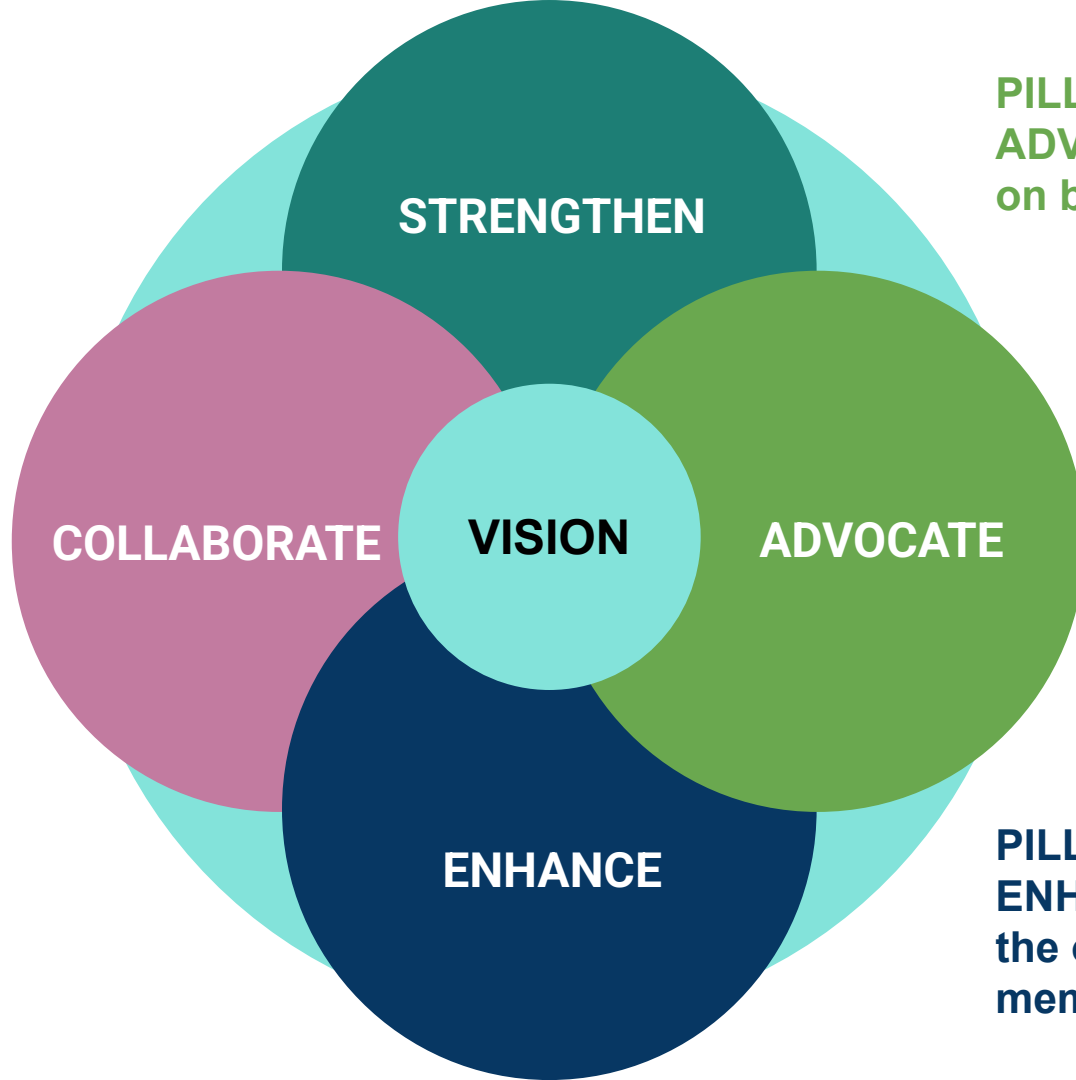
